ON SITE

Normal business hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm. The global headquarters houses Rio Tinto Mineral's Corporate and Technical staff as well as the research and development laboratories and the RTEA Marketing group. Visitors are required to sign in and out daily at the front reception desk and wear a visitor's badge. Hazard recognition training is also required. Safety glasses must be worn in the labs at all times, and visitors to the labs must have a safety escort.

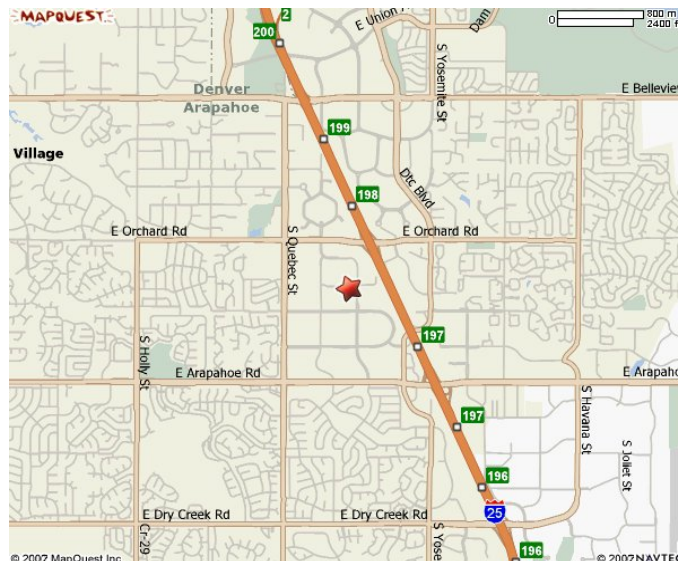
AIRPORT

Denver International Airport (DIA) is located approximately 35 minutes northeast of the Rio Tinto Minerals corporate office. It is serviced by many domestic and international airlines. Our office is located in Greenwood Village, which is south of Denver in the Denver Tech Center.

GETTING TO/FROM THE SITE

From DIA, go North on Pena Boulevard. Merge onto I-70 W/US-36 W via the exit on the left. Merge onto I-225 S via Exit 282 toward Aurora / Colorado Springs. Merge onto I-25 S / US-87 S via Exit 1A on the left toward Colorado Springs. Take the Orchard Road Exit 198. Turn right onto E. Orchard Rd. Turn left onto Greenwood Plaza Boulevard. Turn right onto S. Syracuse Way. Turn left onto E. Maplewood Ave.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Rio Tinto has contracted rates with three local hotels, the Wingate Inn & Suites (303) 221-0383, the Sheraton Denver Tech Center (303-799-6200), and the Drury Inn & Suites Denver Tech Center (303) 694-3400. WEATHER AND ALTITUDE

Denver is the “Mile High” city with an altitude of 5280 feet—or one mile above sea level. The climate is dry, and we experience four distinct seasons. The weather is unpredictable, however, and the season isn’t necessarily a good indication of what weather conditions will be. Summers can be very hot, and winters very cold, but the weather can change at a moment’s notice. The common saying in Colorado is “If you don’t like the weather, just wait 5 minutes and it will change!”

GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

It is unlikely that you will come across any dangerous wildlife while you are visiting the corporate office, but coyotes, snakes, spiders, mountain lions, bears, bees and wasps are all found in Colorado. There are two species of venomous snakes in Colorado—the western rattlesnake and the massasauga. Black widows are the only native venomous spiders (the brown recluse is uncommon and not native.) WHAT TO DO ON WEEKENDS

Denver lies on the eastern slope of the Rocky Mountains. There are areas available for almost any sport, depending on the season, including golf, hiking, white water rafting, skiing, snowboarding, and snowmobiling. Snow sports are generally available from November through April. Due to the climate in Denver, ‘summer’ sports such as golf can often be enjoyed year-round. Denver is the home of the Broncos (football), Avalanche (hockey), Rockies (baseball), and Nuggets (basketball). Downtown Denver, as well as most of its major suburbs, has many restaurants and clubs, as well as shopping and historical sites. The Performing Arts Complex hosts musicals, plays and concerts.
